The School Day

- The children have early morning work from 8:30am which span a range of subjects and skills.

Homework

Homework books come home on a Wednesday.

Spellings and times tables tests will be towards the start of the week.

- **Reading** – 5 x per week. Books need to be in school every day. Please record the book they have read, along with the page numbers read in your child's homework diary. Do feel free to make a comment.
- **Times Tables** – 3 x week. Individualised times tables will begin soon and will then be set regularly.
- **Spellings** - 4 x week. Children will start with 5 common exception words and will receive an additional 5 until they are up to 20 words per week. This gives an opportunity to embed the spellings, transferring to long term memory. During week 5, the children remain with up to 20 spellings with the first 5 words 'falling off' as they receive new ones. Spellings will be put on **EdShed**.
